

DOUGLAS AVENUE CHALK ART CONTEST

CHALK ARTIST GUIDELINES & RULES

Registration closes on October 23 at 5 p.m. CST.

ARTISTS

- Only registered artists may participate in the Douglas Avenue Chalk Art Contest on Oct. 3.
- All artists must read, agree to, and sign Chalk Artist Guidelines & Rules to participate.
- Chalk art spaces will be assigned by Downtown Wichita staff during check-in.
- All artwork must be completed by 5:30 p.m. on Friday, Oct. 3 for judging.
- Groups are welcome to register and collaborate on a single space, with the maximum of people per team being 5.
- Artists must be 18 years or older, unless accompanied by a registered adult.

EVENT

- Artists have from 11 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Friday, Oct. 3, 2025, to complete their artwork.
- Artists are competing to create a design that best embodies this year's theme: "Heartland Stories." Tell a story rooted in the Midwest about resilience, kindness, quiet strength, and creative connection. Whether personal or collective, literal or abstract, capture the feeling of what it means to belong to the heartland.
- Participants will have access to indoor restroom and shade at the Ruffin Building.
- · Water for drinking will be provided.
- Judging will take place by a panel of local community leaders, with the winners announced at 6 p.m.
- The event will go on rain or shine. It will be the responsibility of the artists to cover their own drawings; covers will not be provided.
- In the event of thunderstorms, extra space before the event will be canceled.

CHALK

- One (1) set of water-based non-toxic chalk will be provided. You may purchase or use your own chalk but it MUST be water-based and in solid form.
- If you need additional colors, you may share or exchange chalk with other artists.
- We ask that you return unused chalk to the Artist Check-in.
- Acrylic paints, spray can pastels, oil-based pastels, hard pastels, spray chalk, marking chalk, etc. are not acceptable. Fixatives may not be used on the chalk drawings. Use of any non-chalk or non-washable products will disqualify the art and artwork and artist will be responsible for the cost of clean-up.

ART & SPACE RULES

- Chalk art must be created in assigned and designated spaces only. Each space will measure approximately 12 feet by 12 feet. Artists may use all or part of assigned space.
- All artwork must remain within your designated square no exceptions.
- All artwork must be appropriate for public and family audiences. No lewd content or imagery deemed inappropriate will be permitted.
- Words, symbols, or caricatures intended as political statements are prohibited.

- Art must be respectful and inclusive of all cultures and communities.
- If reproducing artwork by another artist (living or deceased), credit the original artist and title clearly at the base of your piece.
- Keep your supplies minimal and contained within your assigned space.
- No boom boxes or external speakers. Personal headsets are allowed and encouraged.
- No banners, products, samples, or promotional brochures are allowed. Artists may hand out business cards.
- Downtown Wichita staff reserve the right to stop or remove any artwork that violates these rules.
- Sunscreen or shade are the artist's responsibility.
- This event will be photographed and videotaped. These photos and videos may depict the artists and designs and will be used to promote future events.

SUGGESTED SUPPLIES

- · Wisk broom or brush for cleaning the drawing surface. Do not blow the dust particles.
- A 2 foot by 2 foot piece of heavy fabric, carpet square, or cardboard to sit or stand on to avoid smearing your work.
- A soft towel, gardener's pad, or knee pads to kneel on.
- A chalkboard eraser, foam, terry cloth, or shortcut brushes for blending large areas of color.
- Water and a cloth or sponge to erase unwanted parts of your design.
- Old towels or rags to clean up as necessary.
- Masking tape for creating sharp borders and geometry. Tape must be removed when finished.
- Additional chalk, if you need a lot of a certain color.
- Cotton, Latex, or Nitrile gloves to protect your fingertips and assist in blending colors.
- Sunscreen, sunglasses, or a hat to limit sun exposure.
- Canopies allowed, no more than 10x10 at its base.
- Refreshments. Keep open beverage containers away from paintings.
- No glass or alcoholic beverages allowed.
- Camera to take photos of your creation!
